# Sikh Women's Organization of Central California (SWOCC) 2019 College Student Scholarship

## **Background Information**

SWOCC will provide scholarships to outstanding high school seniors in Fresno County to help fund college expenses. This is the first year that \$1000 scholarships will be awarded to three high school seniors who are enrolling in college or university in Fall 2019.

#### **Application Criteria and Selection Process**

Each scholarship will be awarded based on a combination of factors including scholastic achievement, need, involvement in school and extracurricular activities, community service, character, maturity, and vision for the future.

Each application will be independently reviewed and scored by a committee composed of members of the Board of Directors of SWOCC.

### **Eligibility**

All graduating high school seniors from the Sikh community in Fresno County who are attending college or university in the fall are eligible to apply. Annual family income is not to exceed \$60,000.

#### **Application Instructions**

Applicants must use this form as presented and fill it out completely. All applications must be neatly handwritten; altered forms will not be accepted. Only complete applications will be accepted.

For an application to be considered complete, <u>all of the following items must be submitted</u> electronically by the deadline of May 30, 2019:

- 1) application form (including required essay),
- 2) a copy of the FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR) OR parents' 2018 federal tax return (IRS Form 1040)
- 3) a copy of official SAT and/or ACT scores (if required by the college or university),
- 4) an official copy of the high school academic transcript through Fall 2018 (<u>note</u>: transcript must be submitted directly by high school guidance counselor).

**Deadline**: Thursday, May 30, 2019 at 11:59 pm PDT

Method of Submission: In order to submit the scholarship application, by or before 11:59pm

PDT on May 30, 2019,

1) the applicant must email a PDF copy of the complete application form (including essay)

and supporting documentation to the following email address:

2) the applicant's high school guidance counselor must submit the applicant's official high

school transcript by emailing it directly to: swoccscholarships@gmail.com

**Note**: The scholarship funds will be deposited in an account at the institution of higher

education named by the recipient. The college or university will draw directly from the

account as needed to pay for the tuition, fees, room and board, or books of the recipient. The

money awarded may not be used for any other purpose.

If the funds are not expended, they must be returned to SWOCC. All application forms and

related information and submissions will be kept confidential and used solely for the purpose

of the scholarship selection process.
